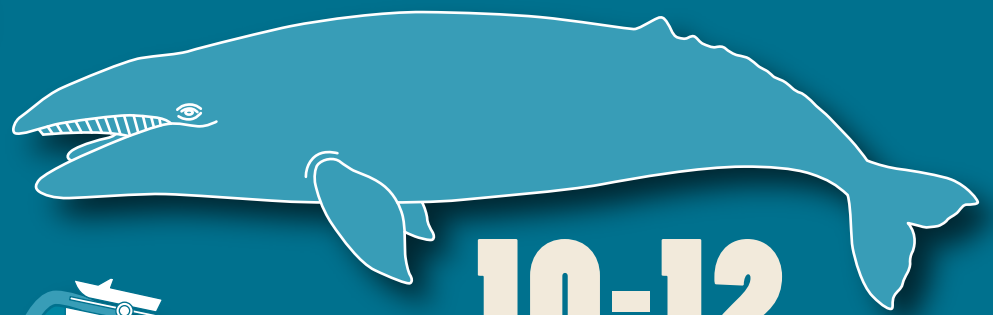




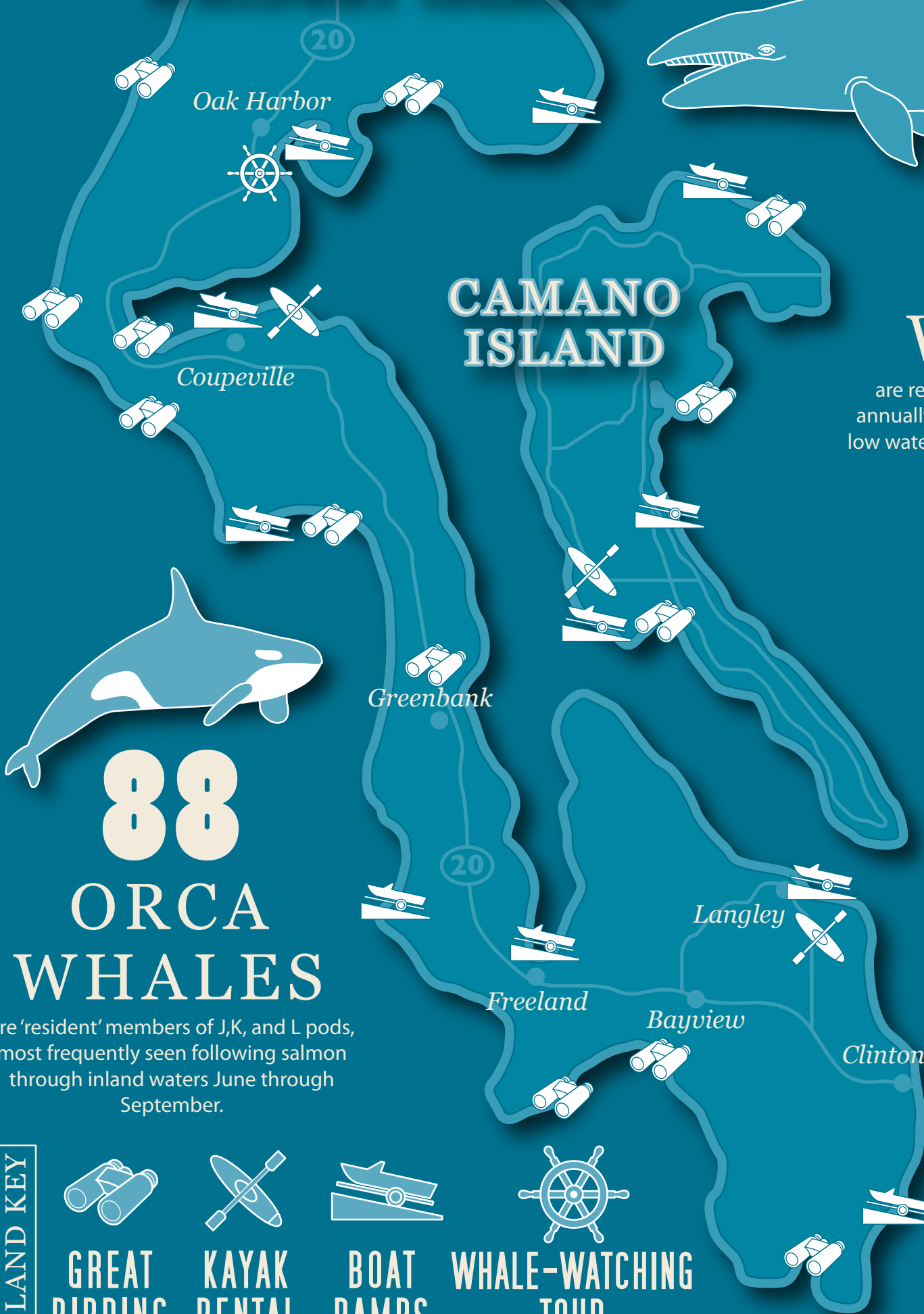

**WHIDBEY ISLAND**



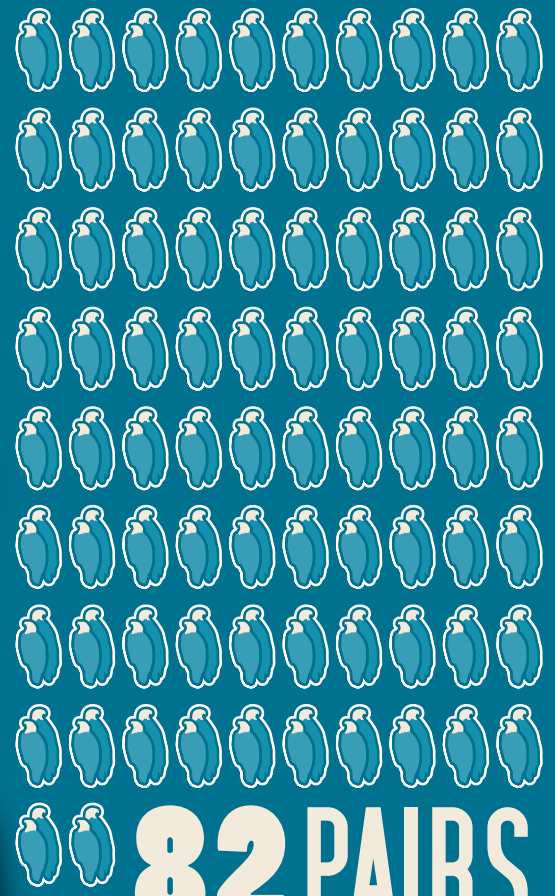
**10-12

nest on the islands. Recently considered an endangered species, now a booming population offers frequent sightings.

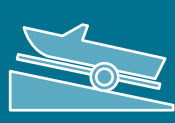

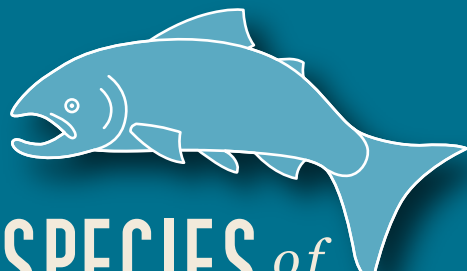
